The Town of Blacksburg would like to personally invite you or your organization to be a participant in the 2017 Holiday Parade to be held on **Friday**, **December 1 at 7:00 p.m.** (A rain date has been scheduled for Saturday, December 2, at 1:00 p.m.) This year's theme is ""Peace on Earth, Good Will to All""

In conjunction with the parade the Town will kick off the holiday season in downtown Blacksburg with shopping, a tree lighting ceremony, and pictures with Santa Claus.

Safety will be our main concern for participants and spectators so please obey all requests concerning the parade. Please see attached rules and regulations before deciding on your entry type.

The deadline for entering the parade is Friday, **November 17, 2017** at 5:00 p.m. While we encourage you to hand out balloons, candy, etc. with your logo, **no solicitation** of materials will be permitted. Also, for continuity sake, we ask that you **please do not have a Santa** in your parade entry; the Town will provide one.

Be sure to mark your calendar for Friday, December 1, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Fill out the enclosed entry form and return it to the address on the parade entry form, or email to rhall@blacksburg.gov, and help make "Peace on Earth, Good Will to All" a memorable parade. Parade Safety: Rules, Regulations, and Helpful Hints

- All decorative materials utilized on parade floats shall be **flame-resistant**.
- All motorized apparatus utilized for parade floats shall be provided with a portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 2-A: 10-B: C rating, to which the operator shall have ready access.
- Any parade float utilizing special effects designed to create smoke, flame, heat, or sparking conditions shall be approved prior to utilization.
- Adult supervision should be provided to all children.
- All floats must be less than 13 feet high.
- **NO** Headlights during parade route.
- A rope should be placed around any truck bed, as a **safety support** to hold onto, where parade participants will be riding.
- Bring a flashlight.
- While we encourage you to give out candy, etc., we ask that you please hand out candy, etc., to spectators (for safety reasons) instead of throwing.
- Please **DO NOT** have a Santa in your parade entry. (The Town of Blacksburg will provide one.)
