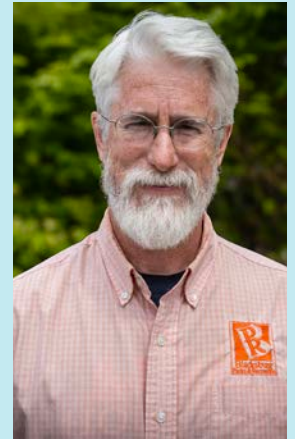

REFUND POLICY

We understand there are times when people need to cancel. Please be mindful when signing up for multiple programs, as cancellations do affect program costs.

- Refund requests made less than seven business days prior to the start of the program, camp, class or rental will incur a \$15 service fee per program.
- Full refunds are only given if the cancellation is made prior to the seven business days.
- There is a \$25 service charge applied to all cash and check refunds.
- Refunds under \$25 will be credited to the household account.
- Credit card refunds are processed three business days after the original transaction.

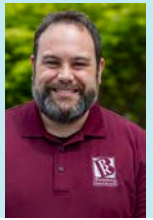

PRIVATE LESSONS
